### You asked

1. **Please tell me how many a) consultant obstetricians and b) anaesthetists are onsite in your maternity department between the hours of 10pm to 8am, Monday to Sunday?**
  - a) One consultant obstetrician is on site over night
  - b) One trainee anaesthetist
  
2. **Please tell me how many a) consultant obstetricians and b) anaesthetists are on-duty but not onsite between the hours of 10pm to 8am, Monday to Sunday?**
  - a) Consultant obstetricians who are on call are all on site.
  - b) Anaesthetists: one general, one neurology and one paediatric consultant are off site
  
3. **Please tell me how many a) consultants obstetricians and b) anaesthetists are onsite on Saturday or Sunday, between the hours of 8am to 6pm?**
  - a) One consultant obstetrician is on site
  - b) One trainee anaesthetist for maternity, one for the intensive care unit and two for general theatres
  
4. **Please state how many a) consultant obstetricians and b) anaesthetists are onsite between the hours of 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday?**
  - a) There is always one obstetrician on site and covering the service as "Week on service". There can be a total of eight obstetricians on site at any one time during the day. However, they will also be covering gynaecology outpatients and theatres, antenatal, fetal medicine clinics etc.
  - b) Anaesthetists within the maternity department: One – AM, One – PM (minimum). On some days, this can increase to two anaesthetists in both the morning and afternoon.
  
5. **Please state the maximum distance on-duty consultant obstetricians and anaesthetists can live away from the hospital?**

30 minutes or 10 miles by road in accordance with schedule 12 of the terms and conditions.
