COVID-19 Patient Passport

The COVID-19 patient passport should be completed for all patients with recent COVID-19 infection prior to admission / transfer to a ward in the Green Zone.

Date of 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test:

There is no requirement for a repeat SARS-CoV-2 PCR screen within 90 days of the 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test.

On Admission to hospital (See Note 3): *(all criteria to be met prior to transfer to a Green Zone bed. If all criteria are not met, then admit to COVID-Red / Amber-step-down for further assessment.)*

Tick all that apply:

- 21 days or more since 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test.
- Absence of acute (new) respiratory illness with symptoms starting within 21 days of 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test.
- No evidence of severe immunosuppression[‡] *(seek advice from specialist team as required.)*

Transfer from COVID-Red or Amber (step-down) wards:

Tick all that apply:

- 21 days or more since 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test.
- (if relevant)* Only in the presence of severe immunosuppression[‡], there is a requirement for documented MDT agreement involving specialist clinicians and Infection Prevention & Control team prior to transfer.

Note:

1. On transfer to a Green Zone bed, patients with previous COVID-19 infection do not require isolation in side-rooms or enhanced infection prevention and control measure, unless required by the Infection Prevention and Control Team for other clinical reasons.
2. Follow infection prevention and control requirements as described in the COVID-19 Zone Status (RAG) Guidelines.
3. For patients with new respiratory symptoms who are past the 21 days since their 1st positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test, consider re-assessment and admission to a Green Zone bed.
4. COVID serology is not routinely required to inform this assessment, but may be helpful in some circumstances to inform clinical decision making.
