Integrated Care Partnership

University Hospitals Plymouth NHS Trust and Livewell Southwest are formally coming together in a partnership so that people across Plymouth and the wider Devon locality can benefit from more joined-up health and social care. This Integrated Care Partnership (ICP) will mean a closer working relationship between several organisations and stakeholders responsible for delivering care in our community, including GPs, Plymouth City Council and the voluntary sector, and ensure that those with complex or long term conditions have their needs met more seamlessly.

As part of the ICP some of the services that were delivered by community providers have been transferred to UHP management and therefore University Hospitals Plymouth NHS Trust is the data controller.
